Excerpts from interview with ecologist, writer and activist Esperanza Martinez, member of NGO Acción Ecológica, Quito. Esperanza questions the efficacy of existing law in dealing with large-scale ecological catastrophes, points out limitations in the concept of 'environment?', and explains the reasons why the Constitutional Law of Ecuador adopts the term Pachamama to define 'nature?'.
